Praised for both his virtuosity and expressive gifts, Jason Vieaux at age 17 was the youngest First Prize winner in the history of the Guitar Foundation of America International Competition. Now 32, he has recently performed on major series at the Kimmel Center in Philadelphia, Cleveland's Severance Hall, Spivey Hall, and New York's Merkin Hall. He has performed as concerto soloist with the Cleveland Orchestra, the Chamber Orchestra of Philadelphia, the Auckland Philharmonia, Santa Fe Symphony and San Diego Symphony. He has been featured on NPR's "Morning Edition," "All Things Considered" and "Performance Today." Mr. Vieaux has eight recordings to his credit. *Sevilla: The Music of Isaac Albeniz*, was rated one of the Top Ten Classical CDs of 2003 by The Philadelphia Inquirer and The Plain Dealer. His latest release is a disc of music by American Jazz guitarist Pat Metheny.

Jason Vieaux will conduct a master class held at Washington University's Music Department, 560 Trinity Avenue in University City, on Sunday, November 4, 1:00-3:00 pm. Admission \$5, free to Guitar Society members.
