French guitarist Thibault Cauvin has dedicated himself since the age of six to the study of classical guitar, under the direction of his father, guitarist and composer Philippe Cauvin. A natural talent, he won first prize at thirteen international competitions before attaining the age of twenty, including the *Andres Segovia International Competition* (Spain), the *Young Guitarist of the Year* (England), and the *Master Guitar Competition* in San Francisco, open only to winners of other guitar competitions. Now twenty-three years old, Mr Cauvin has performed in prestigious halls and festivals in Europe, Canada, Turkey, Morocco and Australia. His January 2004 Los Angeles concert debut was broadcast by National Public Radio. This appearance will be his St. Louis debut.

Thibault Cauvin will conduct a master class held at Washington University's Music Department, 560 Trinity Avenue in University City, on Sunday, November 4, 1:00-3:00 pm. Admission \$5, free to Guitar Society members.
