Formed in 1996 and hailing from Athens, Georgia, **The Georgia Guitar Quartet**--consisting of Jason Solomon, Phil Snyder, Brian Smith, and Kyle Dawkins--has emerged as an exciting new voice in today's chamber music scene. Borrowing from both the past and present, the GGQ draws inspiration from the works of classical masters such as Bach, Brahms and Chopin; experimental artists in the vein of Cage, Bartók, and Stockhausen; and even contemporary rock icons Radiohead and Led Zeppelin. Recent concert highlights include performances in New York, Los Angeles, and a performance of Rodrigo's *Concierto Andaluz* with the Utah Symphony Orchestra. The GGQ has been featured on American Public Media's *Performance Today* and has released four critically acclaimed recordings, the most recent consisting exclusively of music composed by members of the Quartet.
